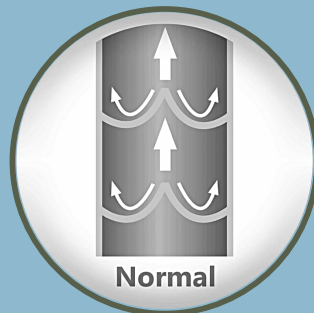

LIVE LIFE WITHOUT VARICOSE VEINS

Varicose veins are NOT a cosmetic issue. If left untreated, they can progress over time to more serious problems such as:

- LEG OR ANKLE SWELLING
- LEG HEAVINESS AND FATIGUE
- BURNING OR ITCHING SKIN
- RESTLESS LEGS
- SKIN CHANGES/ PIGMENTATION

PROGRESSION & DIAGNOSIS

Common risk factors of varicose veins:

- AGE (>40 YEARS)
- GENDER
- FAMILY HISTORY
- HEAVY LIFTING
- MULTIPLE PREGNANCIES
- OBESITY
- EXCESSIVE STANDING

Venous reflux occurs when valves in veins no longer function, and blood begins to travel in both directions, leading to the pooling of blood in the legs. Leg veins then begin to lose form and protrude under the skin as varicose veins.

Venous conditions are diagnosed by a non-invasive ultrasound that takes around 30 minutes. This is the gold-standard for diagnosing the site and severity of venous reflux in legs.



RECOVERY AT TVS

ENDOVENOUS RADIOFREQUENCY ABLATION (THERMAL ABLATION)

- ClosureFast™ catheter produces heat to close the vein
- Results are very successful

ENDOVENOUS CHEMICAL ABLATION (VENASEAL)

- Cyanoacrylate closes a large refluxing vein with single access

ENDOVENOUS CHEMICAL ABLATION (VARITHENA)

- Polidocanol foam assists with closing the vein
- Particularly useful for patients with venous ulcers
